REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) – ADAMS PARK INDOOR SPORTS COMPLEX DESIGN

The City of El Centro is seeking a qualified party to design an Indoor Sports Complex (ISC) and related facilities on approximately 2.2 acres (97,000 s.f.) located between Adams and Park Avenues and 7th and 8th Streets within Adams Park in the City of El Centro.

PLEASE NOTE:

THIS RFP IS AVAILABLE IN TWO ALTERNATIVES FORMS.

In consideration of potential ultimate construction cost, the City of El Centro has released concurrently two (2) versions of this RFP.

- An applicant desiring to design the ISC using composite metal wall panels with steel-frame construction should respond using the RFP package identified as **Fabric Membrane/Truss Frame Alternative**.
- An applicant desiring to design the ISC using a fabric membrane should respond using the RFP package identified as **Composite Metal Wall/Steel Frame Alternative**.

An applicant may respond to either or both alternatives. The City of El Centro reserves the right to choose from only one alternative; reject all responses from one alternative form; or reject all responses to both alternatives.

Written responses to the RFP must be submitted on or before Wednesday, March 3, 2010. Late proposals will not be accepted. Qualified firms/entities will be contacted should an interview or further information be required.
