



Recycling Programs for City of El Centro

- 1) Classroom presentations to El Centro schools on 5 topics: Introduction to Recycling, Buying Recycled Products, Vermicomposting, Household Hazardous Waste, and Used Oil & Beyond.
- 2) Curbside Used Oil Recycling: Residents can call CR&R Waste Services, 482-5656, to sign up for the Used Oil Curbside Recycling Program. CR&R will bring a container for used oil collection and a bag for the used oil filter. The resident will call CR&R when the container is full, CR&R will set up an appointment to pick up the containers and leave empty containers.
- 3) Household Hazardous Waste Facility: Open every Saturday from 8 AM to 12 Noon. The address is 702 E Heil Ave (turn east off Dogwood Road onto Heil Avenue). (Brawley HHW Facility is opened every Sunday 8 AM to 12 Noon, located on Hwy 86 –behind Big Johns Mini Mart.) Accepted Materials: attached Brochure. Also collected at the Facility: Computers, Monitors, TVs, printers, VCRs, Cell Phones, Telephones, Radios, DVD Players, FAX machines, Modems, Routers and Battery Chargers. Any questions, please call Imperial Valley Resource Management Agency at 337-4537. FREE to Imperial County residents—charges apply to businesses. Businesses can call 337-4537 for appointment during the week.
- 4) Tire Collection: The El Centro Household Hazardous Waste Facility also collects passenger and light truck tires at no charge. No more than 9 tires.

- 5) Imperial Valley Resource Management Agency has a Recycling Guide in the AT&T Imperial County Yellow Pages. The Recycling Guide has 10 pages in English and 10 pages in Spanish.
- 6) Certified Used Oil Collection Centers will accept 5 quarts of used oil (stop by for a free used oil container): Shell Rapid Lube, Auto Zone, Kennedy's for Tires, Pro Auto Smog & Service, Kragen Auto Parts, and Pep Boys.
- 7) Curbside pickup bins for Recyclables, Trash and Green waste (call CR&R Waste Services 482-5656)
- 8) Start an Office Recycling Program for businesses at no charge.
- 9) Imperial Valley Resource Management Agency will be at city Cleanups to collect passenger and light truck tires (no more than 9 tires) from residents at no charge and CPUs, Monitors and TVs from residents and businesses at no charge.
